Year Two

- Well done to Year 2 for another hardworking week. As super scientists we started our global habitat research. If your child has anything at home that they want to use for their particular habitat (and it's not too precious!) then please send it in.
- This week in PE, we have been working on improving our aim. If possible, a weekend challenge in an open space could be some throwing and catching or aiming at a target. Practice underarm and overarm throwing to increase accuracy in distance and force needed.

- Harvest poems have come home this week and we have been working on volume and pronouncing words carefully. Please help with regular run throughs at home - thank you.

Year One

- Year 1 have been learning about deciduous and evergreen trees and have used a leaf dial they made to collect and identify leaves. A huge thank you to our helpers for accompanying us on our leaf walk!
- We have read the story "Leaf Man" and have made our own lovely leaf animals.
- We have also been concentrating on letter formation and making sure our lower-case letters are formed correctly.
- In maths, we have started to look at number bonds to 10 and fact families, this includes the commutative and number sentences which start with the answer e.g. $5 + 3 = 8$, $3 + 5 = 8$, $8 = 5 + 3$ and $8 = 3 + 5$. More practice of these at home would benefit everyone. An optional powermaths game to practice number bonds has been uploaded.

Reception

- We have been looking at the composition of numbers to 4, reading the story of the 'Little Red Hen' and enjoying searching for signs of Autumn and making Autumn crowns at Forest School.
- Next week we will be concentrating on our Harvest Festival plans and having some fun with pumpkins.
