- Year 1 have had a lovely and exciting week learning about Holi and making ukeleles in music/DT. We have also been using ipads to find where the UK is on google earth and exploring where England and Wales and their capital cities are. Please practise finding the UK on a map of Google earth more at home.
- We have also been practising finding number bonds to 20, please also practise this at home using toys and discuss how 20 has been made e.g. 14 toy cars plus 6 toy trucks or 12 toy dolls and 8 toy animals, etc. Challenge-can your child write it in a number sentence e.g. $14 + 6 = 20$, $6 + 14 = 20$, $20 = 14 + 6$ and $20 = 6 + 14$.
- Please note-please can all year 1 children bring in a tin can with no sharp edges (e.g. beans tin/coffee tin) at the beginning of next week for another exciting instrument we will be making.
- Please see book bags for reading books and spelling/dictated sentence practise. Mrs Spenceley is very impressed with our neat handwriting and how our reading is coming along 😊
