If you have a child who was born between 1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019, they are due to start school in September 2023 and you must apply for a primary school place for them to start in Reception.

If your child is in Year 2 now, then you will need to apply for their next school for Year 3.

The deadline to submit your application is 15 January 2023

You must apply for a school place even if your child has an older sibling at the school you would like them to go to or they are attending a nursery attached to the school.

This information is for families living in North Yorkshire. Families living outside North Yorkshire will need to contact their home authority to obtain their information regarding school admissions.

Year Two

- Well done to our hardworking Year 2 children for another week of learning. We started our new topic on light and researched some amazing facts about eyes. Ask you child how many times a minute we blink and who blinks the most: men or women; and why?
- We have seen some lovely reading comments from parents over half term. Thank you to those parents who encouraged reading while out and about over the holidays. The Year 2s have come back really enthusiastic and proud of the reading progress.
- Please note:

Help your child to feel organised - it makes a big difference to their confidence.

Year One

- Year 1 have had a great week learning about Diwali and why we celebrate bonfire night. We have also learnt about how to stay safe during bonfire night and wrote instructions on how to stay safe. In maths, we have continued learning how to add using part whole models, ten frames and on a number line and had lots of discussions as to whether it is better to start with the biggest number or smallest number, then add on the rest.

- Spelling books will be sent home on Fridays for you to see our amazing efforts, please return them on Mondays.

Flu Vaccine

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The flu vaccine will be offered to all primary school and SEND children up until the day before their 18th birthday this year. Nasal flu vaccination is delivered in school. There are some occasions where an injection is the most appropriate route for vaccination for some children.

The consent form that the link below takes you to is for Nasal Flu, if you select NO, you will be asked a series of questions to establish if your child is eligible for an injection.
